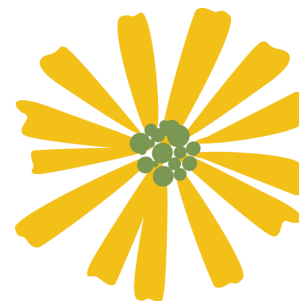
- **Catalyst Grant** - LifeWorks Counseling Division - \$50,000

Get to Know Impact Austin Member Suzanne Daniels!

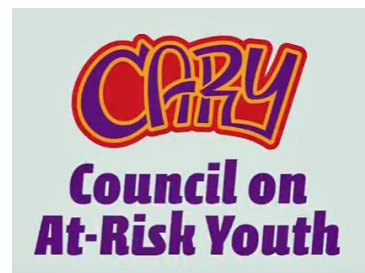

Get to Know Community Partner CARY

Thanks to an \$80,000 Impact Austin grant received in 2015, the Council on At-Risk Youth (CARY) expanded their PeaceRox Aggression Replacement Training Program at Paredes Middle School and also piloted a summer camp at the same school. The programs focus on the students with the highest emotional and behavioral needs who would not otherwise receive services.
